MESSAGE FROM OUR CHAIRS

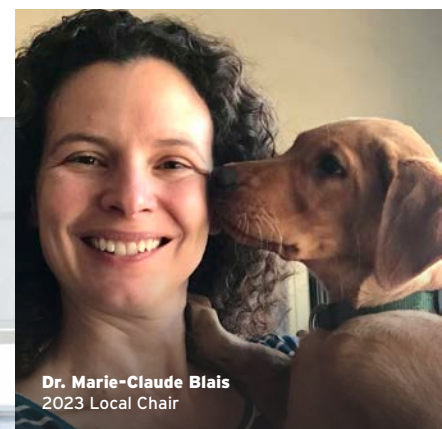

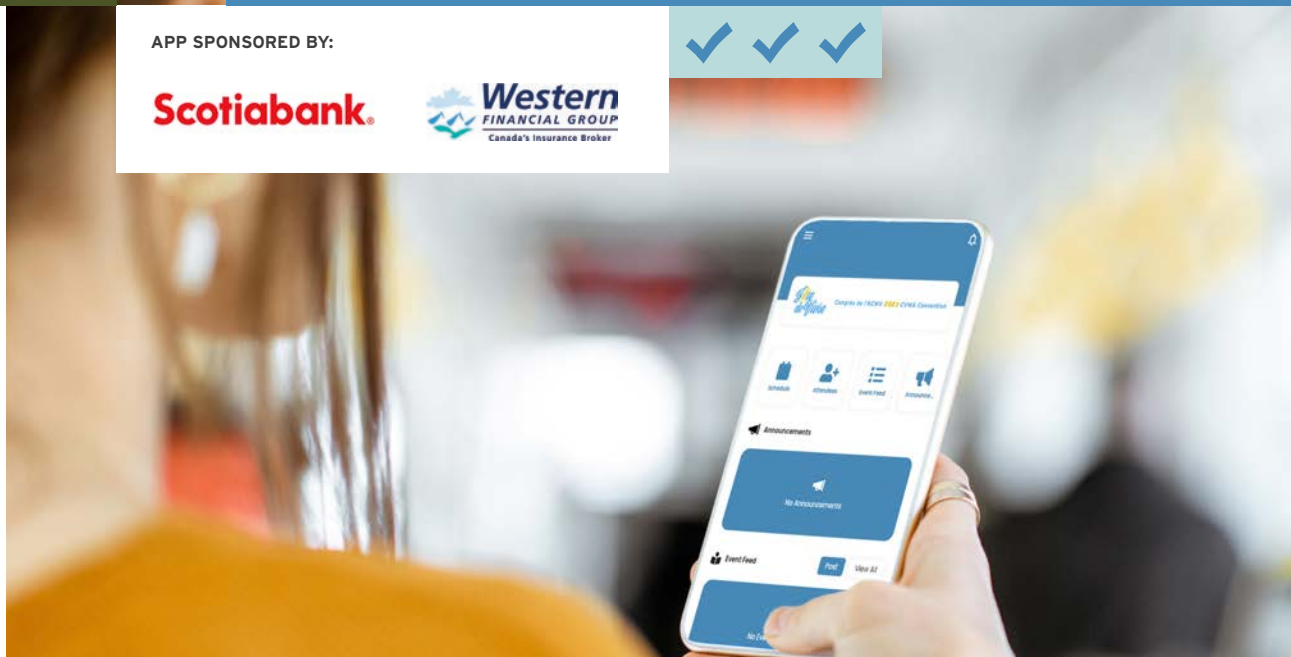
